Purpose of this notice

Turnkey supply of immersive simulators for underground and opencast safety drills - so iCEM can train mine crews on high-risk tasks before they enter the pit.

Scope

- Two full-cabin HEMM / haul-truck simulators with mine-duty scenarios.
- One multi-user AR/VR gallery for roof-fall, blasting, and confined-space drills.
- Curriculum mapping to iCEM capacity-building modules and instructor training.
- Three-year comprehensive maintenance, spare parts, and content updates.

Eligibility

- OEM or authorised integrator with at least three mining / heavy-industry simulator installations in India.
- Average annual turnover of INR 8 crore in the last three financial years.
- Capability to localise scenarios to Indian mine conditions (lignite, bauxite, and hard-rock).
